NOTICE OF ELECTION - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors is the governing body of the GSA Federal Credit Union and consists of nine members. The term of a director is three years with three positions coming up for election each year.

According to the bylaws of the credit union, the Chair of the Board of Directors appoints a nominating committee which is charged with naming at least one nominee for each vacancy. In addition, a member of the Credit Union may be nominated by petition. A valid petition must contain the signatures and account numbers of at least 54 members in good standing with the Credit Union and must be delivered to the Secretary of the Board of Directors at the Credit Union Administrative offices no later than June 6, 2016. Any petition for nomination should be accompanied by a statement by the nominee of his or her willingness to serve on the Board of Directors and a brief biography outlining his or her qualifications to serve as a director. Nominees must be at least 18 years of age.

In the event that there are more than three nominees, an election will be conducted by electronic device and the results announced at the annual meeting. If there is only one nominee for each position there will be no election and the nominees will fill the position for which they were nominated.

INDIVIDUALS NOMINATED BY COMMITTEE:

Fred Bridgers – Mr. Bridgers is retired from the General Services Administration (GSA). He began as a Budget Analyst trainee in the Public Buildings Service in 1971 and retired in 2005 as a Budget Officer in the GSA Office of Budget. Fred is a 1970 graduate of the University of North Carolina and has been a board member of the GSA Federal Credit Union since 1986. He previously served as Treasurer of the GSA FCU and currently serves as Vice Chairman. He currently resides in Elm City, NC where he is active in the United Methodist Church and the Rotary Club.

William Conley – Mr. Conley retired from the General Service Administration in 2002 after nearly 35 plus years of federal service including 2 years in the U.S. Army during the early stages of the Vietnam War. He attended Federal City College on the GI Bill and was awarded a Masters Degree in Education. Prior to his government service he worked in private industry. He also taught Labor Studies part-time for 5 years at Federal City College as an Adjunct Professor. He has been a member of the GSA FCU Board of Directors for over 30 years.

Paul R. Cuddihy – Mr. Cuddihy is a retiree from the GSA Public Buildings Service where his final assignment was Manager, Training Development and Delivery. Prior to his government service, Mr. Cuddihy worked in the private sector in various capacities including; sales, executive search, fund raising, professional development and teaching. He is also involved in several community service activities. He received a B.A. in

English from Georgetown University and engaged in Graduate Studies in Business Administration at American University as well as Graduate Studies in Education at Adelphi University. He has been a member of the GSA FCU Board of Directors since 2010. Prior to that he served on the Supervisory Committee.
